Kyrgyz Republic attaches great importance to the promotion and protection of human rights issues and since its independence demonstrated commitments to the idea of universality of human rights as well as dedication to the principals of democracy and the rule of law.

Kyrgyzstan is a State party to more than 30 principal human rights instruments, including the Convention on the Elimination of al Forms of discrimination against Women; the Convention of the Rights of the Child; the Convention against Torture; the Convention of all Forms of Racial Discrimination; the International Covenant on civil and political rights,

the International Covenant on Economic, social and cultural Rights.
